

Instructions for dyeing with the WEJA Plant Dye Kit

Indigo-Blue



Depth of color shades

Application Method:

1. Dissolve the WEJA-starter powder no. 1482 at room temperature in the amount of water indicated.
2. Place textile in the starter powder solution and move it around in the solution for 5 minutes.
3. Produce the stock solution by adding WEJA powder no. 1548, 1558 or 1568 to 5 times the amount of warm water (40°C). The stock solution will develop a green-yellow color.
4. Slowly add the stock solution to the starter solution containing the textile, moving the textile around. Be sure that the stock solution isn't poured directly onto the textile as this may lead to an uneven dye.
5. Move the textile around in the dye for 30 minutes at 40 - 50°C until it has an even yellow color.
6. Take the textile out of the dye bath and hang it up, avoiding creases. Exposure to the air will make the textile turn blue.
7. Wash the dyed textile after 30 minutes of "bluing-time". Put wool, however, into a sufficient amount of water mixed with vinegar. Finish off by rinsing thoroughly with water.

Storage:

See label.
Opened packets of dye must be used up immediately.

Important Tips:

To be dyed textiles should be pre-washed.

Washing the dyed textiles

Dyed textiles should only be washed with a detergent for color, free of brighteners/bleach and at temperatures up to 40° C. Dyed textiles should the first time be washed separately.
