Application range	For all absorbent materials such as paper, cardboard, gypsum or plasticine.		
Technical qualities	Pure vegetable, mineral. Water-based. Free of organic chemical compounds according to DIN EN 71, part 9. Tested according to DIN EN 71, part 3 – migration of certain elements (heavy metals).		
Full declaration	Water, mineral pigments, methyl cellulose, corn germ oil, sodium benzoate. Bitter substance: Naringin (natural extract of pomelos).

Preparation	Test on the appropriate surface or underground. Stir Finger Paints well.		
Application	Apply diluted with water or concentrated, using a brush, sponge, or fingers. Use a clean spoon or spatula to remove the paint in order to keep a low risk of microbial contamination.		
Drying time	24 hours.		
Specific gravity	1,0 – 1,2 g/ml according to the color.		
Safety advice	Equipped with a bitter substance appropriate for children. Please note that SALIS can dye some fabrics. Attention: Stains on textiles may be permanent. Children under 3 years of age should be supervised by adults.		
Disposal	According to locally regulated laws.		
Container sizes	0.05 l. (also available as a set with 8 x 0.05 l under product n0. 910).		
Storage	Cool and dry. Shelf life: unopened at least 2 years. Once opened, keep product in the refrigerator and use it as soon as possible. Do not return residual paint into the original container for hygiene reasons.
