VARTO Shellac No. 735

Range of application Interior windows. As a final coating of surfaces treated with BASKO paints.

Technical qualities Low viscosity, semi-gloss, transparent.

Dries very quickly, purely physical, i.e. by evaporation of the solvent. Higher water resistance in case of

condensation.

Full declaration Ethanol (grain alcohol), shellac with natural wax content, silicic acid and larch resin.

Color Light honey colored (Gardner color index: approx. 14). Cannot be tinted.

Dilution Ready to use.

Application method With a brush or by spraying.

Coverage 1 l undiluted (1,06 fl. quart.) is sufficient for 12 to 16 m² (129 to 172 ft²) per coat, i.e. 71 ml/m². Test

application!

Drying time At 23 °C (74 °F) and 50 % relative humidity dry to the touch after approximately one hour. Can be painted

over or sanded after approximately 24 hours. Fully hardened after 24 – 48 hours.

Clean equipment immediately after use with BASKO Thinner No. 715.

Specific gravity Approximately 0.86 g/ml.

Safety advice Ensure good ventilation during and after application.

H225 Highly flammable liquid and vapour.

H319 Causes serious eye irritation.

P210 Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking.

P233 Keep container tightly closed.

P243 Take precautionary measures against static discharge.



P280 Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection. **P370+P378** In case of fire: Use Water spray jet, Extinguishing powder, alcohol resistant

Storage Cool and dry, Shelf life: unopened at least 4 years. Close product tightly after use.

How to use

VARTO Shellac No. 735

Preparation Pre-treatment with BASKO paints. Surface must be dry, solid, clean, and free of grease and dust.

Application A sparing, complete application (undiluted) by painting or spraying with explosion-proof equipment.

(Compressed air atomizer: air pressure in bar: 3.0 – 5.0, nozzle size 0.7 – 1.0. Airless: spray pressure 50 –

120 bar, air pressure 2.0 – 3.0, nozzle size 0.007 – 0.011 inch). Don not use in direct sunlight.

Renovation coat Clean with BASKO Thinner No. 715. Pre-sand with a fine grain, remove dust carefully. Then apply VARTO

Shellac No. 735 over the entire surface, as described above.

Important tips Apply sparingly and distribute well all coating layers. Drying takes places very quickly, so you have to work

quickly, otherwise there is risk of visible streaks. Color and gloss level may vary from batch to batch due

to the natural raw materials.

When spraying cover all other areas well.

High humidity (> 65% relative humidity and temperatures < 18°C (64 °F)) can cause whitening during

drying time. If this occurs, sand off and start again.
